Description of your authentication activities and reason for applying for IAA membership (approx 50 words)

The International Authentication Association is established under the law of England and Wales as a company limited by guarantee. This means that it is a not-for-profit company whose members have to contribute an amount up to a guaranteed sum in the event that the company is wound up with outstanding debts. This guaranteed sum is £10 (UK Sterling). Please therefore note the following formal obligation you are making in submitting this membership application:

APPLICATION is made by the organisation named overleaf for membership of the above named Company ("the Company"), subject to the memorandum and articles of association of the Company and to any rules for the time being made thereunder, and to any terms for membership applicable to the Company, and in the event of the Company being wound up while the undersigned is a member, or within one year afterwards, the undersigned undertakes to contribute such amount as may be required, not exceeding the guaranteed sum of £10, for payment of the debts and liabilities of the Company contracted before ceasing to be a member, and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up, and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributions among themselves, and the application fee of £500 (plus VAT if required) will be submitted promptly against the Company's invoice. The undersigned agrees that the Company's annual accounts and director's report and auditor's report on those accounts may be sent by electronic communications to the email address given above.

Note that the membership application fee of £500 will be credited towards your first year's membership fee (currently £3,250 at the prevailing exchange rates) but is non-refundable in the event that your application is not successful.
